  - Review of Board Officers and members
  - Follow-up to the May meeting on the RBNA History initiative
    - Nominated Larry Bird to be the lead
      - Larry suggested: need someone familiar with real estate to help in researching and recording transactions.
      - Potential folks:

        - A few other names were suggested but not captured in the notes

- Communications Mary Bird
  - Newsletter coming soon in September to your mailbox; thanks to Malice for the graphic design of the layout
  - Website was updated to include a page on the Rio Vista Natural Resource Park
  - Mailing list: be sure to sign up via website to receive important announcements
- Treasurer Terry DeCarolis
  - \$2,270.33 (as of July 31, 2021)
  - Expenses: website hosting and printing of new mural cards as a fundraiser (~\$1500 net profit expected) for RBNA
- 4) Neighborhood Enhancement Projects
  - Cactus Rain Garden Estelle
    - 25 neighbors and 15 Watershed Management Group River Run Network volunteers helped to weed and implement erosion control features today (8/21/21); wire cages were placed to protect small native plants as they grow
    - Update of project funding proposals: Tucson Clean & Beautiful did not select RBNA application for Cactus Blvd funding; A meeting is set up for the end of

August to meet with Ward 3 and Tucson Dept of Transportation and Mobility Director to see what City can assist with to enhance this area

- Allen Road/Meadow View Paula
  - Plants are doing well with all of the rain after a long season of watering with help of 8 volunteers; 3 homeowners helped to supply water during dry season
  - Two trees were lost during the cold winter and have been replaced and are growing well
  - Currently, the focus is on weeding
  - o Fall plans: conduct additional plantings and address any maintenance needs
- Allen Road Opportunities Matthew & Catlow
  - Current focus is on Allen Rd neighbor engagement to review and ID opportunities
  - Ideas or concerns please chat with Matthew and/or Catlow
- Rio Vista Natural Resource Park Planning Lindy Brigham and Mary Bird
  - Actively meeting to identify and move forward on current issues with Ward 3:
    - Parks & Rec has never defined a "Natural Resource Park" and is communicating with Pima County to create a definition for the City before planning process starts
    - Public input will be part of the definition process
    - May include funding for a restoration ecologist to help with park enhancements
  - Questions and Suggestions:
    - Patricia: suggested that we should look at other Natural resource park definitions from other regions
    - Leila: how does this relate to the Friends of Rio Vista group? -- these are separate groups/efforts and all voices will be part of the public process
